Part of Si Automation SECS Pack 1.1, **AreYouThere 1.1** is a **free** software tool designed for end-user SECS/GEM communication management.

AreYouThere 1.1 is a simulator of a SECS communicating entity able to exchange messages with an equipment that complies with the Semiconductor Equipment Communication Standard (SECS).

AreYouThere 1.1 is provided with a set of libraries which allow the user to easily send, receive, log and create messages. Messages comply with the SECS-II standard and are communicated across either SECS-I or HSMS links.
